1 Section 93B Inference for Means: Paired Data PERFORM significance tests for paired data are called: paired t procedures Comparative studies (ie 2 observations on 1 individual or 1 observation on 2 similar individuals) are more convincing than single-sample investigations One-sample inference is less common than comparative inference
